- Similar to the meeting of the Red and Assiniboine River in Winnipeg, this conference will facilitate the coming together of diverse individuals, whose thoughts and perspectives will be interwoven to build fresh insight and learning for our community.
- The conference will value past experiences and use those experiences to work in the present and guide us into the future.
